



fable: a fictitious story meant to teach a lesson

version: a performance or interpretation of a piece of music, poetry, drama, story, or character's role

moral: a lesson, usually regarding right or wrong , taught by a fable

virtue: a moral quality that is regarded as a good or meritorious, i.e., generosity, kindness

vanity: being excessively proud of one's self, looks, possessions, abilities

flattery: excessive compliments, insincere praise, exaggerated attention

allusion: an indirect reference or casual mention

personification: a figure of speech in which a thing, quality, or idea is represented as a person

minimalist style: a style which uses the least possible amount (minimum) to convey meaning

proverb: a commonly used short saying that expresses an obvious truth
