



article: a non fictional piece of writing that forms an independent part of a publication, as of a newspaper or magazine

byline: a line at the head of a newspaper or magazine article carrying the writer's name

dateline: a phrase at the beginning of a newspaper or magazine article that gives the date and place of its origin

editorial: an article in a publication expressing the opinion of its editors or publishers

headline: the title or caption of a newspaper article, usually set in large type

journalism: the collecting, writing, editing, and presenting of news or news articles in newspapers and magazines and in radio and television broadcasts

journalist: a person whose occupation is journalism

photojournalism: journalism in which a news story is presented primarily through photographs with supplementary written copy
