Planting Sunflowers

Plant the sunflowers seeds you have on your desk, using the following instructions:

1. Pass out a paper cup to each student. Have the students write their names on their cup.
2. Fill the cup almost to the top with damp soil.
3. Poke a hole about 1" deep for each seed.
4. Place a seed in each hole and cover with soil.
5. Put all cups on a waterproof tray in a place that will receive plenty of sun.
6. Water as needed.
7. It should take 5-10 days for the seeds to sprout.
